SOUTHERN AUSTRALIA

After the cars are collected in Melbourne the rally will explore some of the great routes along the coast including the Great Ocean Road before turning inland and visiting a series of typical Australian towns in Victoria before dropping into Canberra and turning south back to Melbourne and the ferry to Tasmania.

From Melbourne we drive the Great Ocean Road and The Twelve Apostles to Warrnambool. The next day we drive on to Portland Bay then head up via Mt Gambier, Lindsay and Balmoral to Horsham. Heading east we explore the roads to Bendigo via Halls Gap, Beaufort and Ballart. Then it's up to Rutherglen through Mitiamo, Echuca and Yarrowonga. As usual we find the best roads with superb scenery and great little stops.

From here we make a visit to Canberra in Australian Capital Territory. Heading south the rally goes to Bairnsdale before making its way to Melbourne where we pick up the overnight ferry to Tasmania. A cabin is included in the entry fee.

TASMANIA

Tasmania may look like it has few roads, but don't be fooled, many of them are not on some of the popular maps. We will not only take you on some unchartered roads but will combine the human and natural worlds to give a real Tasmanian experience. With a unique wilderness, unusual wildlife, extraordinary arts and fabulous food, it's a truly stunning drive.

We have a great set of routes including many used on the internationally renowned Targa Tasmania stages,

including High Plains, Moriarty, Elephant Pass, Grasstree Hill, Tinderbox, Molesworth, Gunns Plain, Nook and many more.

While these are taken flat out on the Targa we will drive them with a view to experiencing the stages without the haste.

The Tiger Tasmania is designed to give you the time to see and appreciate the roads, countryside, people, art and history from Cradle Mountain to the Bay of Fires, not to mention the odd national park, incredible lakes, harbours and beaches.

With multiple rest days we have the opportunity to sample the local cuisine, visit museums and historic sights and get a chance to catch our breath.

WHAT SUPPORT DO YOU GIVE?

to keeping cars on the road in all conditions.

WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE ENTRY FEE?

Apart from great driving, exceptional routes and our fantastic team, the entry fee always includes all your accommodation on rally days, breakfast and most evening meals including a welcome and final gala dinner. On Competitive events we include trophies and comprehensive results. On every event there is a rally bag containing a detailed roadbook, some clothing appropriate to the event, pens, clipboards etc. We also include car decals, rally plates and on Touring events we provide a GPS to make sure you get round with ease.

WHAT ARE YOUR ENTRY REQUIREMENTS?

For most events we like to have pre-1980 cars as around this time they started to become more complicated and include computers. However, if you have a later classic and are prepared to accept that we cannot repair the electronics, then give us a call and if we like the sound of it, you are welcome to join us.

WHAT DO I NEED TO NAVIGATE ON A COMPETITION RALLY?

You need a trip meter from Brantz, TerraTrip, Monit or similar. We suggest you have a couple of clocks in the car and read the rules and regulations carefully.

HOW DO I ENTER?

Complete an entry form as far as you can at the time and send it with a deposit to Bespoke Rallies. We will write back and confirm you have been successful. The entry form should be accompanied by a deposit as specified. If you have any queries please feel free to call the rally office. Our T&Cs are on the website.
